

HONEYMOON VISA FOR SWITZERLAND

- Passport should be valid for at least three months beyond the intended duration of stay in the Schengen area with minimum two blank pages. Passport must not be older than 10 years i.e. must not be issued before 01.01.2001
- One visa application form to be filled completely and signed by the applicant
- Two recent color photographs, 35 x 45mm in size with white background, matt finish and face should cover 80% of the photo area
- Covering letter from the applicant on company's letter head stating his name, designation, purpose and duration of visit
- Proof of airline reservation for a round trip e.g. Reservation slip
- Original wedding invitation
- Overseas medical insurance valid for the country with the minimum coverage of 30000 euro. The insurance has to cover all risk e.g. Accident, illness e.t.c.The policy must be clearly specify the period of validity and has to cover the date of arrival and departure and has to be submitted in original along with photocopy
- Proof of accommodation: hotel reservation including the name and phone number of hotel
- Two copies of passport first and last page to be submitted
- If required by the embassy of Switzerland, an applicant may have to attend a personal interview with them. The interview will be scheduled by the embassy of Switzerland. The date and time of the interview will be intimated by the embassy of Switzerland on the contact number provided by the applicant on the application form
- The visa fee is payable through demand draft made in favor of "Embassy of Switzerland", payable at New Delhi
- Proof of sufficient funds
 - Bank statement for last 6 months including address and telephone number of the bank, a/c holder's name, address with stamp & signature of bank
 - * Income tax returns for last 3 year
 - * 3 months salary slips
- Authority letter-If an applicant is not in a position to submit his/her application in person, under such circumstances it is mandatory that their representative/agent should produce a authority letter

- Applicants should not purchase their tickets before their visa is approved where proof of tickets issued is not listed in the checklist as a mandatory document to be provided with the application.
